On 5-14-50, Moyer B-4 No. 17 was acidized from 3860' to 3892' with 1,000 gallons acid. After acidization well flowed 10 barrels oil and 6 barrels water in 24 hours by gas lift. Production before acidization was 6 barrels oil and 2 barrels water in 24 hours by gas lift.
