Re: Application for Administrative Approval of a 240-Acre Non-Standard Cas Provation Unit, Eumont Gas Pool, Comprised of SW 1/4 and the S 1/2 SE 1/4 of Section 5, T-21S, R-36E, Lea County, New Maxico

Gentlemen:

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The Atlantic Refining Company respectfully requests administrative approval under provisions of Rule 5 (b) of NMOCC Order No. R-520 for a non-standard gas promation unit for its State "G" No. 1 well, located 560' from the south line and 1980' from the west line of Section 5, T-21S, R-36E, Sumont Peel, Lee County, New Mexico. The proposed non-standard gas promation unit is to consist of the 240 acres comprising the SW 1/4 and the S 1/2 SE 1/4 of the above described section. Upon approval of this non-standard unit, it is requested that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Countission Administrative Order NSP-38 dated December 18, 1954, be cancelled.

In support of this application, the following facts are submitted:

1. The Atlantic Refining Company is the owner and operator of oil and gas leases known as the Atlantic State "E" and State "G" leases which cover the SW 1/4 of Section 5, T-21S, R-36E, Lea County, New Mexico, and that the Atlantic Refining Company and the Tidewater Oil Company are the owners and The Atlantic Refining Company the operator of an oil and gas lease known as the Atlantic Tidewater State "C" lease which covers the S 1/2 SE 1/4 of Section 5, T-21S, R-36E, Lea County, New Mexico, and The Atlantic Refining Company the operator of an oil and gas lease known as the Atlantic Tidewater State "C" lease which covers the S 1/2 SE 1/4 of Section 5, T-21S, R-36E, Lea County, New Mexico,

2. The Atlantic Refining Company's State "G" No. 1 well was dually completed November 1, 1954, as a gas-oil dual in the Eurice-Monument and Euront Pools in accordance with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order DC-31.

3. A plat is attached herete showing the proposed 240 acre non-standard gas proration unit, the location of the Atlantic State "G" No. 1 well, and the location of offset wells.

4. The proposed non-standard gas provation unit complies with the provisions of Rule 5 (b) of Order R-520 in that

(a) it is composed of contiguous quarter-quarter sections,

(b) it lies wholly within a single governmental section.
