By means of this application The Atlantic Refining Company wishes to state the following:

- (a) That The Atlantic Refining Company is the owner and operator of oil and gas leases known as the Atlantic State "E" and State "G" leases which cover lots 19, 20, 21 and 22 of Section 5, T-21-S, R-35-E, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (b) That The Atlantic R<sup>2</sup>fining Company desires to form a 160 acre non-standard gas provation unit consisting of lots 19, 20, 21 and 22 of Section 5, T-21-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (c) That The Atlantic Refining Company's State "G" Mb. 1 well, located in the center of lot 22, Section 5, T-21-S, R-36-E, was dually completed November 1, 1951; as a gas-oil dual in the Eunice-Monument and Eumont Pools in accordance with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order No. DG-31. The appended plat shows the location of the proposed 160 acre non-standard gas provation unit, the location of the Atlantic State "G" No. 1 well, and the bocation of offset wells.
- (d) That the proposed non-standard gas provation unit till comply with Rule 5(b) of the Commission's Order No. R-520 as follows:
  - . The proposed unit will consist of contiguous lets.
  - 2. The proposed unit will lie wholly within a single governmental section.
  - 3. The entire proposed unit is productive of gas.
  - b. The length or width of the proposed unit does not exceed 5280 feet.
  - 5. All offset operators have been furnished, by registered mail, a copy of this application on this date; thereby giving notice to such operators of Atlantic's intention to form this non-standard gas provation unit. (See attached affidavit).
