Total depth, S.L.M. is 3866. Six feet of jelly seal from 3866' to 3860'.  
 Acidized from 3836' to 3860' with 3000 gallons Western 15% acid. Acid kept  
 at specified depth by controlling pressure on casing. After swabbing in and  
 being allowed to clean up, well made 110 barrels in 24 hours where formerly  
 it made 60 barrels on 9/64" choke.
