DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Set $12\frac{1}{2}$ inch 50# second-hand lapweld casing at 251 feet in redbed with 200 sacks of cement. The total depth of the hole was 299 feet and size of hole was $17\frac{1}{2}$ inch. Plug was on bottom 10:00 a. m. February 25th, and the cement was allowed to stand 38 hours before plugs were drilled at midnight February 26th. The hole was jetted dry before and after drilling the plugs, and the shut-off was found to be O. K. Cement was circulated behind this string by pump and plug method.
