DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Set 9 5/8 inch 36# new lapweld casing at 1241 feet in anhydrite with 500 sacks of cement. The total depth of the hole was 1461 feet and the size of the hole was 12 1/4 inch. Cementing was done by the pump and plug method, and cement was circulated within 50 feet of the bottom of the cellar. Plug was on bottom 6:00 p. m. March 2nd and cement was allowed to stand 78 hours before plugs were drilled. Tested with 1200# pressure before and after drilling the plug and shut-off was found to be O. K.
