NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand wherever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in R. Olsen
Well No. 1 in 17 1/2 SE 1 of Sec. 5, T. 21S., R. 36 East,
N. M. P. M., Runice Oil Field Loa County,
on July 27 19 35 13-5/8- 32 b. casing was encore cemented in Anhydrite
formation at a depth of 1350 feet on July 27 19 35
500 sacks of Encore cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows:

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of bottom feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
