Re: Application for 240-acre Non-Standard Gas Production Unit, Eminent Gas Pool, Comprising SE/4 and Lots 15 and 16, Section 6, T21S, R36E, Lea County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas production unit comprising the SE/4 and Lots 15 and 16, Section 6, T21S, R36E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is owner and operator of oil and gas leases known as their Grant "A" Lease, a portion of which is located in Lots 15 and 16, Graham-State "E" Lease, located in the W/2 of the SE/4 and R. E. Hall Lease located in the E/2 of the SE/4, all in Section 6, and is the 240 acres described above. The State of New Mexico holds the royalty under each of the above tracts.
- (2) The Graham-State "E" #2 located 1980 feet from the East line and 1980 feet from the South line of Section 6, T21S, R36E, Lea County, New Mexico, was completed September 26, 1936, in the Eminent Oil Pool at a depth of 3885 feet, and an application to finally complete the well in the Eminent Gas Pool was approved by the Commission on April 24, 1954. The applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.
- (3) The proposed non-standard gas production unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission's Order No. B-520 as follows:
 - (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
 - (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.

Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a
non-standard gas production unit consisting the 240 and lots 12 and 16, sec-
tion 6, T21S, R13E, New Mexico, and in support thereof states
the following facts:

(1) Gulf Oil Corporation is owner and operator of oil and gas
leases known as "Gulf" lease, a portion of which
is located in lots 12 and 16, Graham-Storey "B" lease, located
in the 1/2 of the 240 and N. E. Bell lease located in the
1/2 of the 240, all in Section 6, and is the 240 acres
as described above. The State of New Mexico holds the royalty
interest in the above tracts.

(2) The Graham-Storey "B" lease located 1930 feet from the east line
and 1930 feet from the south line of Section 6, T21S, R13E,
New Mexico, was completed September 26, 1936, in
the Prince Oil Pool at a depth of 3885 feet, and an applica-
tion to qualify complete the well in the Prince Oil Pool was
approved by the Commission on April 26, 1936. The applicant
proposes to use this well as the unit well.

(3) The proposed non-standard gas production unit will meet the
requirements of Rule 2(d) of the Oil Conservation Commission's
Order No. 1-230 as follows:

(a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the
unit.

(b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single govern-
mental section.
