Gentlemen:

By this letter of application Gulf Oil Corporation wishes to state the following:

- (a) That Gulf Oil Corporation desires to dual complete the subject well in lieu of R. R. Bell "B" No. 1 for which authority to dual was granted by Commission Order DC 51.
- (b) That Gulf Oil Corporation Graham State "E" No. 2, located in the IW/4 SE/4 of Section 6-T-21-S, R-36-E, was completed September 26, 1936 at a total depth of 3885'. The attached Exhibit "A" shows the location of this well on the Gulf Oil Corporation Graham State "E" Lease with the location of all offset wells.
- (c) That subject well has 5-1/2" casing set at 3749' and cemented with 300 sacks of cement. The well is an oil well producing from the open hole interval from 3749-3885' in the Eunice Fool.
- (d) That the applicant proposes to dually complete the well in the following manner:
 - (1) Perforate the 5-1/2" casing within the approximate interval of 3435-3675' in the Aumont Gas Pool.
 - (2) Set production type packer below these perforations at approximately 3700' to separate the two pay zones.
 - (3) Produce the Eunice Pool oil through the tubing and the Eumont gas through the tubing-casing annulus.
- (e) That the granting of this application for permission to produce the well as a dual completion with gas from the Eumont and oil from the Eunice is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights.
- (f) That the applicant will comply with all rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to maintain separation of production from the two pay zones.
