the purpose of producing their respective shares of Eumont Pool gas under such acreage and have agreed to use the Gulf Oil Corporation H. T. Grentt "C" Well No. 8 as the unit well.

- (5) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission's Order No. R-520 as follows:
- (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
 - (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
 - (c) All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas.
 - (d) The length or width of the proposed unit does not exceed 5280 feet.
 - (e) By copy of this letter of application, all operators owning interests in the section in which the proposed unit is located and all operators within 1500 feet of the proposed unit well are notified by registered mail of the intent of Gulf Oil Corporation and The Atlantic Refining Company to form the proposed non-standard gas proration unit. (See attached affidavit.)

In view of the existence of the facts herein stated and compliance with the provisions of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission's Order No. R-520, Gulf Oil Corporation requests that the Secretary of the Commission approve the above described non-standard gas proration unit.
