Gentlemen:

We are enclosing supplement # 92 to the September proration schedule which authorizes an advance allowable of 1500 barrels of oil for the Gulf Oil Corporation, H. T. Orcutt C 8-B, 6-21-36, Eumont Pool.

This advance allowable is authorized for the purpose of testing the Queen zone in the Eumont pool. If the well is completed as an oil-gas dual the production against this advance allowable will be considered as oil production incidental to gas production if, however, it is decided to complete the well as an oil producer in the Queen zone it will be necessary that the Grayburg-San Andres zone be plugged off and the production against this allowable will be charged against any future allowables assigned to the well.
