DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

8-5/8" 28# 8-Thd. New Seamless casing was set in this well at 2689' and cemented by the Halliburton Method.

Casing and fittings were tested with 1200# pressure and allowed to stand for thirty minutes undisturbed. The pressure did not drop. Cement plug was drilled out of casing and the same test was again applied and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. There was no drop in pressure.
