Additional information:

On first flowing test thru open 22" tubing well produced at the rate of 16 barrels per hr. on 20 hr. test with a gas-cil ratio of 4,400. Bebinson rubber packer was then set at 5797'. Well was swabbed in and produced 252 barrels eil in 24 hours with a gas eil-ratie of 302. This production was on 24/64" tubing choke. On open tubing well would produce only approximately 1 barrel per hour. Well was completed with out acidization.
