Drilling was completed on this well March 8, 1936. Produced 60 barrels fluid with 6,000,000 cubic feet of gas, on a 6 $\frac{1}{2}$  hour test. Ran Robinson Rubber Packer at 3821' and perforated 5' below. Treated with 2000 gallon Dowell XX Acid. Swabbed in and turned into tanks on 17 hour test and produced 412 $\frac{1}{2}$  barrels, or hourly average of 24 barrels of pipe line oil. This test was made on a 1" Choke. Gas-Oil ration 703.

This well will be placed on prorated allowable March 16, 1936.
