This well was drilled to a total depth, of 3890'. 2 1/2" Upset tubing was run to 3870'. The well was swabbed in pit for 10 hours. Then started flowing and flowed in tanks for 5 hours and made 148.5 barrels. Hourly average of 29.7 barrels. Flowing through 1" open choke. Daily gas rate of 450,000. Gas oil ratio of 651. Clean oil.
