## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 124 jts 3861' of 2-3/8" OD 4.70# tubing w/2-3/8" x 6' Std. Anchor on bottom. Set at 3866' Perf. at 3862', 5 1/2" Lane Wells Type BOC Hookwall packer set at 3638'. Four Merla Type W Flow valves from bottom up as follows: 525# at 3626', 550# at 2979', 575# at 2203', and 600# at 1245'.

RESULTS: Initial flowed 111 oil 2 water thru 2-3/8" tubing WO in 24 hrs. ending 29th. Formation gas volume 98,910 cu.ft. Formation GOR 891/1. Input gas volume 68,250 cu.ft. Input GOR 614/1. Allowable 43 bbls per day exempt. Daily average production before workover 47 oil 5 water for June, 1952. Allowable before workover 43 bpd exempt.
