FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On November 1, 1943, our application was approved to transfer the allowable production from well #3 to well #2 on our M. Campbell lease. The reason for this transfer was that the gas-oil ratio of No. 3 was 59,046 while the gas-oil ratio of No. 2 was 683, and it was thought that the allowable production of these wells could be produced by this arrangement and effect a conservation of gas. Recently water has encroached on well #2 to the extent that it will no longer produce its allowable production. The GOR limit in this pool is 6000, and it is therefore believed advisable to cancel the transfer and allow each well to produce its own allowable. A new GOR test on well #3 will be subsequently submitted.
