I am listing on separate sheet the reports required by our department
for well drilled on state or patented lands. I am also enclosing
a copy of our Bulletin #2 which contains all the details.

Our policy is to return approved copies of the following:

you desire others please attach note to the reports and we will be
glad to comply with your request.

You will probably notice in Bulletin #2 that we require;
FIVE DAYS NOTICE on several of the notices of test. I realize that
it is impossible to know that far in advance and I would suggest
that your local superintendant get in touch with myself by telephone
about 12 to 24 hours prior to the tests on each of the three strings
of pipe. Also in case you want to shoot the well. In this way it will
not be necessary to wait for permission to make test.
