Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas production unit comprising the SE/4 of Section 8, T-21-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as its R. R. Bell "A" Lease located in the S/2 of SE/4 of Section 8, T-21-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The Atlantic Refining Company is owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as its State "B" Lease located in the N/2 of SE/4 of Section 8, T-21-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The Gulf and Atlantic Leases comprise the 160 acres above described.
- (2) Gulf Oil Corporation proposes that the above described acreage be established as a non-standard 160-acre gas production unit in exception to Rule 5(a) of Order R-520.
- (3) Gulf Oil Corporation is the owner and operator of the R. R. Bell "A" Well No. 2 located 660 feet from the East line and 660 feet from the South line of Section 8, T-21-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico, which was completed January 22, 1935, as a gas-oil dual well. This well is in the Eminent Gas Pool and Eunice Oil Pool. The applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.
- (4) Gulf Oil Corporation and The Atlantic Refining Company have agreed to communitize their respective leases to form a 240-acre unit which would comprise the 160 acres covered by this application and an additional 80 acres

The Atlantic Refining Company is owner and
operator of an oil and gas lease known as the R. E. Well
located in the 1/4 of 31/4 of Section 8, T-21-S,
R-36-E, New Mexico. The Gulf and Atlantic
leases comprise the 100 acres above described.
- (2) Gulf Oil Corporation proposes that the above described
lease be established as a non-standard 100-acre gas
production unit in exception to Rule 5(a) of Order H-20.
- (3) Gulf Oil Corporation is the owner and operator of the
R. E. Well No. 1 located 600 feet from the east
line and 60 feet from the north line of Section 8,
T-21-S, R-36-E, New Mexico, which was com-
pleted January 22, 1935, as a gas-oil well. This
well is in the Bureau Gas Pool and produces oil and gas.
Applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.
- (4) Gulf Oil Corporation and the Atlantic Refining Company
have a need to commensurate their respective leases to
form a 100-acre unit which would comprise the 100 acres
covered by this application and an additional 6 acres
