### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Was treated with 1000 gallons of 50% Hydrochloric Acid Solution by the Chemical Process Company. 3 Barrels oil were pumped in through the tubing, followed by the 1000 Gallons of Acid Solution, and then 20 barrels of oil. Pressure on the casing 475 #, tubing none, at the beginning and 300 # Tubing and 650# Casing pressure at close.

24-Hour test before acidizing 99 barrels Oil  
 24-Hour test after acidizing 690 Barrels oil and 350,000 Cu Ft of Gas.
