## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was treated with 250-gallons of Dowell Acid with intention of treating with 2000-gallons after the 250-gallons had cleaned the hole, but after doing this the well was swabbed in and it flowed 21-bbbls the first hour, 24-bbbls second, 20-bbbls third, and 20-bbbls during the fourth hour with 22% sulphur water and estimated 400,000 cu ft gas. We do not plan on treating well any more as it will flow the allowable, will take official test in a few days.
