Gentlemen:

Continental Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of statewide rule 112-A to dually complete in the Eunice oil pool and Eumont gas pool its Meyer B-9 well No. 2 located 1980 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the West line of Section 9, T-21S, R-36E, NMPM Lea County, New Mexico. A plat attached hereto shows the manner in which the dual completion is proposed to be accomplished. The Meyer B-9 No. 2 is producing oil through perforations at 3745 to 3784 feet opposite the Greyburg formation. It is proposed to perforate the Queen formation from 3385 to 3425 and 3522 to 3570 feet for gas production. The Eumont gas will be produced through the casing tubing annulus while Eunice oil is being produced through the tubing. The fluids from the two reservoirs will be completely separated by appropriate packers, and the well will be so equipped that the reservoir pressure of each of the two pools may be determined separately. Well head equipment will include all necessary connections to permit accurate measurement of fluids produced by each pool as may be required by the Commission.

A plat is attached hereto showing to the best of our knowledge and belief the proposed unit, the location of the No. 2 well and other wells on the lease, offset wells and ownership thereof.

The granting of this application is in the interest of preventing waste and the protection of correlative rights.
