DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Treated well w/2000 gallons Dowell XX; ran 11 bbls. oil ahead with tubing pressure dropping from 1200# to 150# w/casing pressure remaining at 1200#; with first 1000 gallons tubing pressure dropped from 150# to 40#; began 2nd thousand gallons pressured back to 75#--let set 10 minutes and it fell back to 40#; the last 400 gallons went in with 20" vacuum; followed with 30 bbl. oil load.

First hour: flowed 100 bbls. oil thru casing.

Second &

Third : flowed 18½ bbls. per hr, thro 2½" tubing.
