DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

TD of well 3880'. Pulled rods, spotted 100 gallons jel seal loaded with oil and treated from 3797' to 3880' with 750 gallons jel and 2000 gallons 15% acid. Tubing pressure 2000# to 500# casing pressure 2000# to 500#. Flushed well with oil. Swabbed well at rate of 4 bbls. fluid per hour 2% BS&W. Ran rods and placed well on pump. Well now pumping 41 barrels per day with a shakeout of 30%.

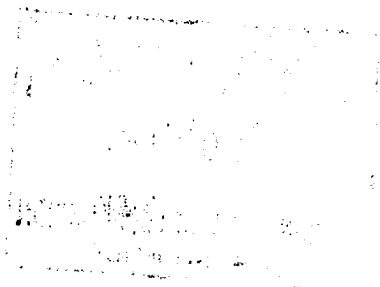
