Exxon Corporation requests administrative approval for a 320 acre Non-Standard Eumont Gas Proration Unit comprising the W/2 of Section 10, T-20-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico. Currently Exxon's A. J. Adkins non-standard unit consists of 280 acres assigned to Exxon's A. J. Adkins Well No. 4, located 660' from the west line and 1980 from the south line of Section 10, consisting of the W/2 of Section 10, except the NE/4 of the NW/4, Section 10.

The above request is made to enlarge the current non-standard unit consisting of 280 acres to include the NE/4 of NW/4, Section 10 operated by W. H. Brady, Roswell, New Mexico. The requested non-standard unit will be styled as the A. J. Adkins Unit, Well No. 1.

In support of this application, we submit the following:

1. The proposed non-standard unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
2. The non-standard unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
3. The entire proposed non-standard unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
4. The length or width of the non-standard gas unit does not exceed 5280 feet.
