- 8. Skelly Oil Company operates NE/4 NW/4 Section 10, Township 21 South, Range 36 East. This 40-acre tract is jointly owned by Skelly Oil Company and Humble Oil & Refining Company. It has been determined mutually that it is impractical to include this 40-acre tract in the proposed unit.
- 9. A plat showing the proposed non-standard gas unit together with offset properties indicating well locations and lease ownership to the best of our knowledge is attached hereto.
- 10. All offset operators are hereby notified by a copy of this application.

Wherefore, the petitioner requests that, in the interest of conservation and protection of correlative rights, the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission grant an exception to Rule 5(b) of Order R-520 as amended without hearing, by which the petitioner may operate the above described lands as a single unit.
