Alternate Procedure: If in step (2) above the casing caliper reveals the casing in too poor condition to produce gas through the casing tubing annulus, then the procedure following the casing caliper will be as follows:

- (3) set a bridge plug and dump cement on top of it with a dump bailer on a wire line to shut off the lower Humble pay, (4) run tubing, replace oil with salt water, and pull tubing, (5) perforate the Humont pay from 2895-2918, 3055-3097, 3430-3465, 3480-3535 and 3560-3620 feet, with two jet shots per foot, (6) run tubing and packer, circulate out salt water with oil, set packer at approximately 2750 feet, swab well in and place on production.
