Killed well with water & aquagel. Pulled 2" tubing and re-ran same with 4-3/4" Robinson Packer set at 3785'. Swabbed water load out of well above packer. Well started flowing - cleaned out and tested 3 bbls. fluid per hour - 4% water - through 12/64" choke. Gas-oil ratio 2167.
