It is proposed to acidize this well on the above date with 500 gallons of acid. This work to be done by the Chemical Process Company. This is a new well and bottomed at 5525'. 3-1/2" casing was set at 5725' and the well will be treated between this casing seat and the total depth. The acid will be flushed out promptly to prevent damage to the casing seat. No water or shale formations are exposed in this well. The well was tested for 10 hours on June 28th and made 25 barrels of oil.
