DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Pulled rods and tubing, cleaned out, reran 2" tubing. Treated with 1000 gallons of Western 15% acid. Maximum and minimum casing pressure 1000# and 1000#. Swabbed well in and tested 16 hours on 14/64" choke. Made 19-1/2 barrels of oil and 9 barrels of water on April 24. Tested well 24 hours on 3/4" choke on April 25 and 26, made 9 barrels of oil and 3 barrels of water. GOR 108,400 cu./ft./barrel. Well temporarily shut-in pending additional work to correct gas-oil ratio.
