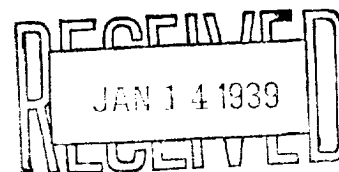
Necessary firewalls constructed. All brush and trash cleaned out around well.
