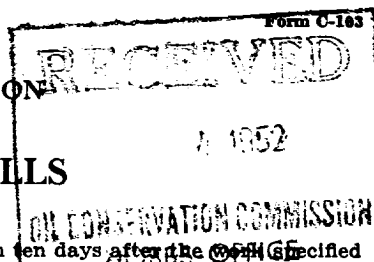

On 2-30-52, the subject well flowed 14 bbls. oil and 7 bbls. water.

In order to increase oil production, the open hole section from 3777' to 3900' was acidized with 2,000 gallons 20% acid.

After acidizing well flowed 11 bbls. oil per day, sustaining 8 hours.

Work was completed and completed 3-11-52.

Plans are to install pumping unit on this well.
