On 9-8-36 10-3/4" OD casing was run and set at 307' and cemented with 250 sacks cement.

After cement has been allowed to set 48 hours, plug will be drilled and hole bailed dry. The hole shall remain dry for 2 hours thereafter to constitute satisfactory proof of a water shut off.
