(40-acre Subdivision)
Lea County.

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

In an attempt to restore Oil production, the following work was performed and results obtained.

After stimulating with sand-oil frac of 20,000 gallons oil plus 30,000 lbs. of sand, well produced 100% water. A water shut-off attempt was performed using a kerosene-cement slurry consisting of 150 sacks. Well was swabbed dry, and cement drilled out to 3835; washed with 500 gallons acid. On test recovered 14 barrels load oil and 687 BW in 36 hours.

In order to recomplete as a gas well, we propose to:
Run radio active logs and plug back above Grayberg. Perforate intervals in the Yates-Seven Rivers as indicated by logs and stimulate with 20,000 gallon sand oil frac; cleanup and return well to production.
