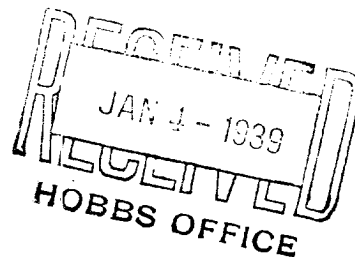

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Permission is requested to centralize McQuatters #1 & #2 tank batteries. Central tank battery to consist of 4 TP 500 barrel Steel Tanks. Production of both wells to be handled by one separator. Production tests will be made once every two weeks on #1 and #2 by producing each well separately, in order to determine choke size that will conform with allowable by producing both wells continuously, thus balancing production from each 40 acre unit.
