## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

As outlined on Form C-102, dated July 10th, the subject well was acidized with 2000 gallons of acid from 3800 to 3840 in order to stimulate an increase in production

Previous tests indicate well was producing only 32 BOPD and subsequent<sup>to</sup> this acidization, production has been increased to 45 BOPD and 20 Bbls. of water per twenty-four hour period through 2" tubing and a 16/64" choke.
