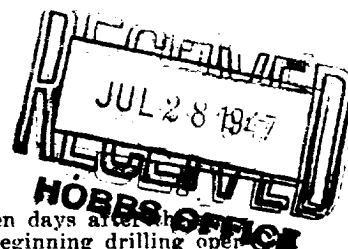

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was deepened from 3858' to 7145' to test the Drinkard Pay, which we found non-productive. We plugged back with cement to 6845', then placed cement plug from 5400 to 5100. Then plugged back with cement from 4300' to 3830', then perforated from 3830 to 3855, to recomplate in the Eunice Monument Field. We ran Exner-Dodge formation anchor packer with bottom of rubber at 3825'. Well then was swabbed to bottom through tubing and packer tested OK. Well then recomplate in the Eunice Monument Field. Cement was drilled out to a total depth of 3855'.
