This well was drilled to a total depth of 3858' and completed in July 1936, and is still producing from that depth. 7" OD casing was set at 3698'. We plan to deepen this well to an approximate depth of 7000' to explore the Drinkard Pay, and if productive at that depth, will run 5" OD casing to total depth and perforate. The 5" OD casing will be cemented back into the 7" casing.

Production on the above well in the Eunice-Monument pay has steadily decreased until it is not profitable to operate.
