Dear Sir:

With this application, Mid-Continent Petroleum Corporation respectfully requests an exception to Rule 2, Order No. R-520 Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, under Rule 3 of the same order. Information concerning the application is as follows:

- (a) Description of acreage involved is E/2, SE/4 of Section 11 and W/2, SW/4 of Section 12, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico. The well involved is the C. W. Marshall Well No. 2 located 660 feet from the East line and 1980 feet from the South line of Section 11, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (b) The attached plat, EXHIBIT "A", shows the acreage to be dedicated, the well location, offset gas wells, and offset ownership.
- (c) Application for hearing for the formation of a non-standard proration unit under Rule 5 (a), Order No. R-520 has been filed.
- (d) All royalty owners under the subject acreage have signed unitization agreements for this proposed unit.
- (e) The well is located 660 feet from the two nearest lease lines and under Rule 5 (a) of the above order will have a maximum of 160 acres assigned to it.
- (f) It is proposed to plug back the Mid-Continent Petroleum Corp. C. W. Marshall Well No. 2, now producing in the Eumice Oil Pool in the above stated location, and recomplete in the Queen zone within the vertical limits of the Eumont Gas Pool. Mid-Continent Petroleum Corp. respectfully requests the Oil Conservation Commission to grant this exception as this unorthodox location is occasioned by the recompletion of a well previously drilled to another horizon.
- (g) All operators within a 1980 foot radius of the subject well as well as all offset operators have been furnished a copy of this application by registered mail. The mailing list is attached.
