7" OD 24 1/2 LOT Casing set at 3699' and cemented with 300 sacks Trinity Portland Cement in Lime. Casing was allowed to set for 72 hours then tested by building up a pressure of 1200# and allowed to set for 30 minutes. Tested OK. The plug was then drilled and casing was retested by building up a pressure of 1200# and allowed to set for 30 minutes. Tested OK.
