Hole was drilled to 3886 and tested. Estimated 5 bbls. oil per hr., with 2,100,000 cu.ft. gas, natural. 4000 gallons of Dowell XX acid were run and set for 3 hours. Well swabbed and acid, water and b.s. run into pits for 9 hours. Then oil tested in tanks 333 bbls. oil in 12 hrs. with 2,200,000 gas.

**DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED**

Well Spudded January 16 and hole drilled to 251 feet, of 10-3/4", 40# Lap Weld pipe was run. Heavy mud was circulated ahead of cementing and 155 sacks of cement were run. Cement returns to the cellar. Additional sacks of cement were used to floor the cellar. Cement stood ~~30~~ 30 hours, plug was drilled and hole bailed dry for shut-off test and found to be satisfactory. Drilling continued.
