DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Hole was drilled to 3700 feet; 5 1/2", 17# New Seamless casing was run 3698. Heavy mud was circulated and pipe was cemented with 150 sacks of cement, cementing pipe 1200 feet up the hole. 650# pressure was put on the pipe and maintained for 48 hours. Plug drilled, hole bailed and pipe found to be o.k. Drilling fluid was changed to oil, using flush joint drill pipe. Drilling resumed.

7-5/8", 26# New Seamless casing was run to 1555 ft. and cemented with 350 sacks of cement. Heavy mud was circulated before the cement was run. The plug stopped at 1340 ft. 1200# pressure was maintained on the pipe and found to be O.K. after 48 hours. Plug was drilled, hole bailed and pipe found to be O.K. Drilling resumed.
