Following is a report on the work done and the results obtained under the heading noted above at the Two  
States Drilling Company and Southern  
Petroleum Exploration, Inc., McQuatters Well No. 2 in the

Center of SE of the NE of Sec. 11, T. 21 S., R. 36 E., N. M. P. M.,  
Runice Field, Loga County County.

The dates of this work were as follows: December 12 & December 14, 1936.

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well spudded December 14, 200 feet of hole drilled, 197 feet of 10-3/4", 40# Lap Weld Pipe was run. Heavy mud was circulated ahead of cementing and 150 sacks of cement were run. Plug stopped at 180 feet, with cement returns to the cellar. Additional sacks of cement were used to floor the cellar. Pressure was put on the pipe and pipe capped, and stood for 30 hours. Plug was drilled, and hold bailed dry for water shut-off and found to be satisfactory. Drilling continued.
