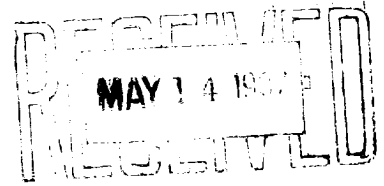

It should be signed and sworn to before a notary public for reports on beginning drilling operations, results of shooting well, results of test of casing shut-off, result of plugging of well, and other important operations, even though the work was witnessed by an agent of the Commission. Reports on minor operations need not be signed and sworn to before a notary public. See additional instructions in the Rules and Regulations of the Commission.

Following is a report on the work done and the results obtained under the heading noted above at the **Two States Drilling Company and Southern Petroleum Exploration** **Mary L. McQuatters #3** Well No. **3** in the

Company or Operator **SW 1/4 NE 1/4** of Sec. **11** Lease **215**, R. **36E**, N. M. P. M.,
Field, **Lea** County.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Hole was drilled to 3670 feet, 5½" new seamless 17 pound casing was run to 3669; heavy mud was circulated and pipe was cemented with 250 sacks of cement on May 3, 1937. On May 5, 1937 hole was tested with 1200 pounds of pressure for thirty minutes and found O. K. Drilling continued to 3865. Total depth. Well was tested on May 7th natural estimated 500 barrels oil per day 3,000,000 feet of gas. To cut down gas-oil ratio 3,000 gallons acid were used and well again tested on May 9, 1937 and tested 132 barrels oil 3 hours and 600,000 cubic feet of gas daily.
