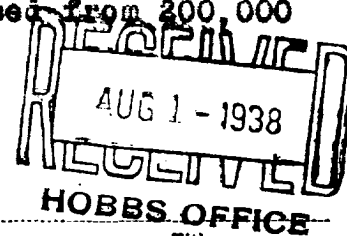

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was acidized with 2000 gallons Dowell XXW from 3692' to 3829'. Total depth of hole 3829'. Work was done by Dowell Incorporated. Oil was increased from 35 barrels of oil per day to 1250 barrels in 12 hours. Gas increased from 200,000 cu. ft. to 3,000,000 cu. ft.

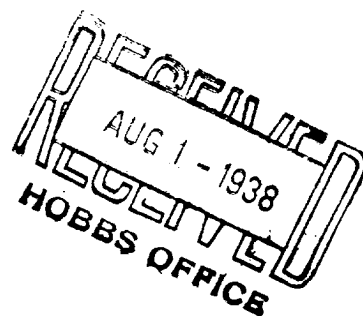
