After shot washed to bottom with oil, and unloaded hole, and it tested an estimated 840,000 cu ft gas.

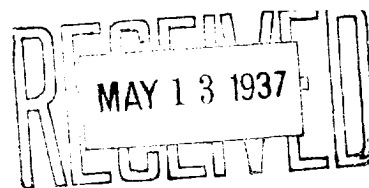

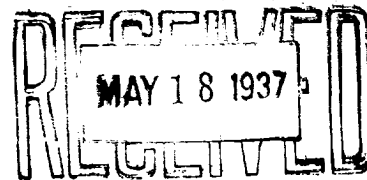
