**DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED**

On August 20th, 1936 the 7-5/8" Casing was cemented at 1213' W/650 Sax Cement by the Halliburton Cementing process. The cement did not fill up into the cellar, The temperature bomb run and cement found to be at 275'. The Casing was ripped with Bash-Ross ripper at 550, 275, 255 & 230' and circulation not regained. Ripped and circulation recovered at 220', Ran Halliburton Test Plug and recemented with 123-Sax Cement by the Halliburton Cementing Process. The cement circulated in the cellar and the 7-5/8" casing now completely cemented to top.
