WHEREAS, the Secretary of the Interior has received from the Secretary of the Army a report of the results of the investigation of the cause of the failure of the dam at the mouth of the Colorado River, and has determined that the same is due to the negligence of the Secretary of the Army, and has accordingly recommended that the Secretary of the Army be censured for such negligence, and that the Secretary of the Interior be authorized to take such action as may be deemed proper in the premises.
