NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in State "B"
Well No. 2 in SW/4 NW/4 of Sec. 16, T. 21S, R. 36E,
N. M. P. M., Burise Oil Field Lee County,
on March 12, 1935 36 lb. casing ~~xxx~~ ^{will be} cemented ⁱⁿ Salt
formation at a depth of 1750 feet on March 12, 1935
500 sacks of El Toro Regular Oil Well ^{will be} cement ~~xxx~~ used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: Halliburton plug method with pressure.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of 1750 feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.

Adjacent property owners have been notified as follows: Empire, Continental and Tidewater
are now being notified by letter.

Additional information: Will test water shut off March 14, 1935.
