NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible.

If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in State "B"
Well No. 3 in NE/4 SE/4 of Sec. 16, T. 21S, R. 36E,
N. M. P. M., Eunice Oil Field Lea County,
on June 14, 1935. 24 lb. casing was { cemented } in Lima
formation at a depth of 3755' feet on June 14, 1935
400 sacks of El Toro Regular Oil Well cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: Malliburton plug method with Pressure.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of 3755' feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.

Adjacent property owners have been notified as follows: Gypsy, Continental and Prairie are being notified by letter.

Additional information: Will drill plug and test cement job June 17th, 1935.
